The CEH exam is a knowledge exam with multiple-choice questions, it does not include performance-based questions to assess hands-on skills - a second practical exam is required.



COSTS MUCH LESS The CompTIA PenTest+ exam and learning products are half the price.

CEH costs twice as much and charges extra for the remotely proctored exam and second practical exam (if hands-on assessment is needed).
